

#### Christmas Sleigh Instructions:

1. For whitework, trace the pattern using white ink. You may trace additional holly twigs separately as 3D elements . The sleigh may also be traced separately and attached as another 3D element.
2. Emboss the traced pattern including those traced separately.
3. Fill up the empty spaces in the middle of the pattern with grid work using a fine mesh grid or an “extra” fine grid as in finished picture ( extra fine grid available at [keniashilpa@yahoo.com](mailto:keniashilpa@yahoo.com)). Also fill up with grid work the upper portion of lace bottom border.
4. Perforate the areas for cutwork by referring to the finished picture.
5. Cut out all perforated areas.
6. Position the correct placements for your desired 3D elements and glue sparingly.
7. Attach a coloured Christmas background to your finished work.

#### Christmas Greeting Instructions:

1. Trace the circular background motif using white ink.
2. Trace separately the greeting card elements using the appropriate shade of colour.
3. Emboss the circular background. You may fill up the outer border with gridwork using a regular grid or “extra” fine grid as in finished picture. (extra fine grid available at [keniashilpa@yahoo.com](mailto:keniashilpa@yahoo.com)) .
4. Colour the the greeting card attachments using a medium of your choice.
5. Perforate the outlines of the background pattern including the vertical lines. Perforate the outlines of the greeting card attachments.
6. Cut out all perforated areas.
7. Position the correct placement of the greeting card in the middle of the circular background. Glue sparingly.
8. Attach a coloured Christmas backing to your finished card.
