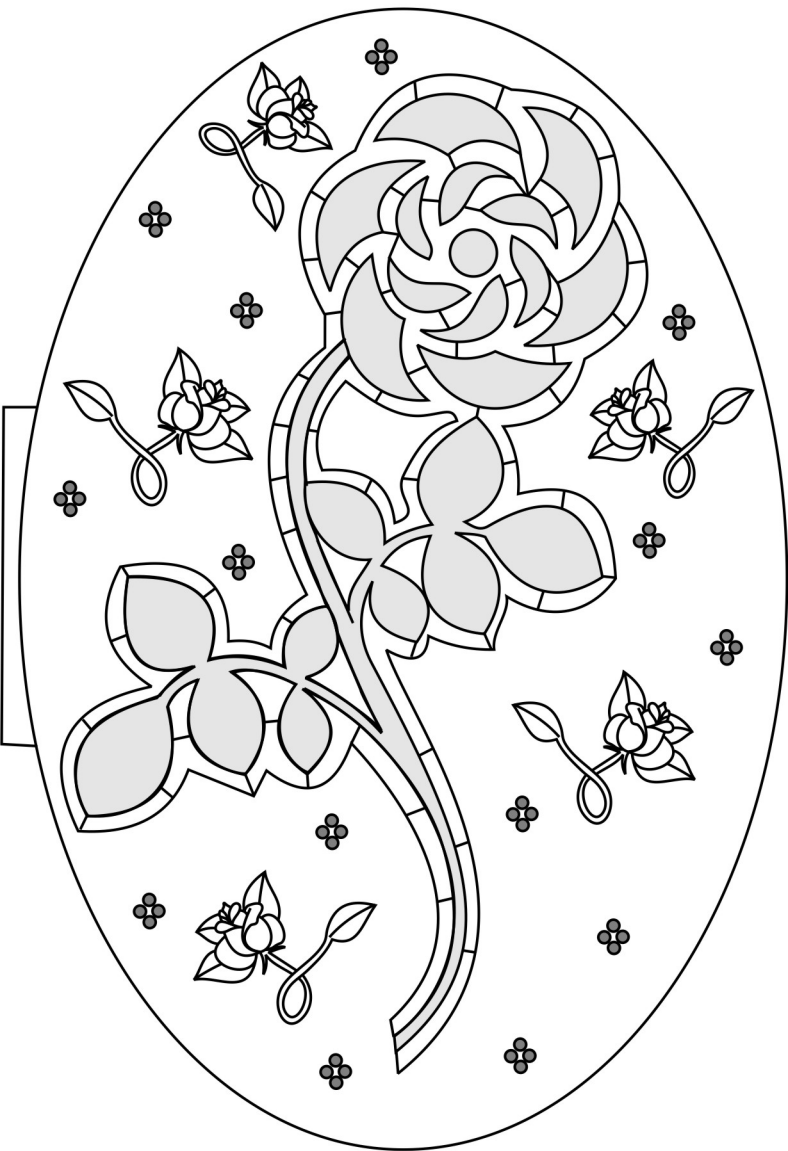




Flower Cutwork



FLOWER CUTWORK

Materials

Clear parchment paper
Pink parchment paper (optional)
White ink or white pencil
Ball embossing tools
Two needle perforating tool
Regular-mesh grid
Square perforating tool
Semi circle perforating tool
Scissors or snips
Glue
Pink Cardstock
Rhinestone (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS

TRACE

Trace the complete flower cutwork pattern on a clear sheet of parchment paper including the oval border. The fold line of the card is situated on the left side of the pattern.

EMBOSS

Emboss the smaller rose motifs inside the oval pattern. Thicken the flower cutwork outlines using a small ball embossing tool. Emboss the flower dots.

GRID WORK

Fill up the spaces (in grayscale) with grid work using a regular mesh grid and a square perforating tool.

PERFORATE

Perforate within the outlines of the main flower motif. Perforate around the oval border using a semi circle perforating tool. Refer to the finished picture to determine other areas that will require perforations and cutwork.

CUT OUT

Cut out all the perforated areas except the spaces designated for grid work.

FINISHING

You may trace a second layer of the oval background using a sheet of coloured parchment paper. A piece of rhinestone embellishment can be glued to the center of the flower cutwork. Attach a heavy cardstock to the finished card to support the delicate cutwork.
